

Mike:

Per your request we are preparing to put together the 2020 C2P2 DCNR grant application for the playground, outdoor exercise areas, and ADA connections for those areas at Community Park. I have included below an outline of major project tasks to be completed, including those that will need to be completed by the Borough. Please be advised that the work elements below and work schedule are based on our understanding that the Borough will be doing an all-cash match and no in-kind services are to be used. I have also included below a schedule including dates for when we will need the match resolution and adoption of the park plan by Council and when we will need support letters to be turned in. Right now I'm aiming for the 4/6/20 Borough Council meeting for adoption of the park plan and the match resolution; this will be the last Council meeting prior to the grant application due date (4/22/20). Please let me know if this timing is acceptable. Please feel free to contact me with any questions, comments or concerns.

Boucher & James, Inc. Work Elements

- Fill out online grant form including detailed project scope, project criteria questions, goals and priorities, outreach, implementation and stewardship, and other narrative text as needed.
- Provide assistance with preparation of the match resolution, final park plan and any supporting information, if required.
- Compile and upload all supporting documentation for grant application
- Prepare and provide a support letter template for use by partner/supporting organizations
- Prepare and provide text for County municipal notification letter
- Review and update budgetary figures for elements to be included in grant application
- Finalize any revisions to the park plan and upload with the grant application
- Review grant application with the Borough prior to submission and make revisions/corrections as needed
- Attend final electronic signing/submission at the Borough to provide assistance with final submission of grant application

- Borough Support letters and County notification letter to B&J (3/30/20)
- Borough Council Adoption of match resolution and final park plan (4/6/20)
- Borough Review of draft grant application (4/10/20)
- B&J Final revisions to grant application (4/17/20)
- Borough authorized signatory or their designee electronic signing/submission of grant application (4/21/20 latest date)




