It's hard to believe that summer is right around the corner. And this summer we have a lot to look forward to in Souderton!

I grew up going to Concert Sundaes in Souderton Park with my grandparents, Harold and Sally. Every week we would pack up our lawn chairs and head over to the park early to get "our spot" with enough time to get a hot dog and ice cream before the start of the show. When getting to the park became a bit too difficult, we would just sit outside at home and, if the wind was blowing in the right direction, listen to the

live music play throughout Souderton. Eventually I joined the Concert Sundaes Committee to ensure that future generations could make the same wonderful memories that I enjoyed.

Have you been to Concert Sundaes? I sometimes hear "Oh, that's just for old people". Wrong! Maybe this is the summer you should come give it a try. Concert Sundaes (yes, spelled "Sundaes" for the delicious ice cream served) has been a staple in this community for more than three decades. Now in its 36<sup>th</sup> season, this year is set to be better than ever! Our 2023 lineup includes new acts including a 1980's cover band, a Bruce Springsteen cover, and a Motown act, along with tried-and-true classics like the Allentown Band and Merion Concert Band. Every week is meant to be different to suit a wide array of musical tastes. This years lineup has me particularly excited.

Not sure what it's all about? Concert Sundaes is FREE to the public. Every Sunday evening between June and August at 7pm, come to Souderton Park, bring a lawn chair or a blanket, and enjoy the live music. Bring a little cash with you for a hot dog, pizza, and an ice cream sundae with all the fixings, reasonably priced and served to you each week by a different community group. A concert is never cancelled. If there is a threat of rain, we simply move to Indian Crest or Souderton High School for the show. To me, Sunday evenings in the park are what living in a small town is all about. If you're not there, you're missing out!

This year you'll notice some awesome improvements to our venue. Souderton Park is undergoing a major overhaul spearheaded by the Souderton-Telford Rotary Club. This includes upgraded lighting to the bandshell, re-pointed stone, improved landscaping and drainage, improvements to the pavilion, a new gaga pit, and of course, the addition of incredible new playground and adult fitness equipment. We have added a new building near the pavilion that houses public restrooms, a kitchen facility, and storage for Concert Sundaes. Souderton Park is quickly becoming a premier destination for families throughout our area. Due to the construction and improvements, I regret to remind you that there will be no more fireworks in Souderton Park.
