Signs

A building permit is required to erect, construct, enlarge, add to, alter, repair, replace, improve, remove, install, or maintain any structure or building. This includes accessory buildings such as pools, decks, patios, garages or car ports, etc. The provisions of the Borough of Souderton Code of Ordinances and the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code control the requirements for building permits.
