BOROUGH COUNCIL WORK SESSION

Monday, July 20, 2026 (7:00 pm)

Borough Council President Pro-Tem Stephanie Costa called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Present were Councilors Costa, Rogers, Cross, Dill, Richter (at 7:45p.m.), and Mayor Yocum. Also present were Solicitor John Torrente, Chief OBrien, Wastewater Supervisor Tyler McCarthy, and Manager Sara Jarrett-Eaton. Absent were Councilors Sholly, Munden, Littlefield, and Bencsik.

Sewer Items- The monthly department report was provided to the council in their meeting packet. Supervisor Tyler McCarthy provided additional updates to Borough Council and answered any questions.

Public Works Items - The monthly department report was provided to the council in their meeting packet.

Recreation Items – Mrs. Jarrett-Eaton provided a brief update on the pool season, park pavilion rentals, and fall recreation offerings.

Police Items- The monthly department report was provided to the council in their meeting packet. Chief OBrien provided departmental updates and upcoming events.

Administrative Items- Borough Manager Sara Jarrett-Eaton provided a brief report including an update on the 2024 and 2025 audit process and the beginning of the 2027 budget process.

Councilors went into executive session at 7:30 p.m. to discuss personnel, the collective bargaining agreement, and litigation. Councilors returned from executive session at 8:36 p.m.

Councilor Dill made a motion to approve the tolling agreement for a period of six (6) months with respect to a residential real property located at Fairview Avenue, subject to final form of agreement acceptable to the Borough Solicitor and Manager. The motion was seconded by Councilor Richter and passed by majority vote. Councilor Costa abstained from the vote due to personal interest.
