BOROUGH COUNCIL WORK SESSION

Monday, August 17, 2026 (7:00 pm)

Borough Council President Stephanie Costa called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Present were Councilors Costa, Rogers, Cross, Dill, Richter, Sholly (at 7:45p.m.), Littlefield, Bencsik and Mayor Yocum. Also present were Solicitor John Torrente, Chief OBrien, Sergeant Lukens, Public Works Director Jason Kelly, and Manager Sara Jarrett-Eaton.

Sewer Items- The monthly department report was provided to the council in their meeting packet.

Public Works Items - The monthly department report was provided to the council in their meeting packet. Director Jason Kelly provided additional details regarding upcoming projects.

Recreation Items – Mrs. Jarrett-Eaton provided a brief update on the pool season, park pavilion rentals, and fall recreation offerings.

Police Items- The monthly department report was provided to the council in their meeting packet. Chief OBrien provided departmental updates and upcoming events.

Administrative Items- Borough Manager Sara Jarrett-Eaton provided a brief report including an update on the 2027 budget process and expected capital expenditures in the new year.

Council Committee Items- Councilors reported that several of the committees were scheduled for the upcoming week or prior week.

Discussion Items- Borough Councilors and the Borough Manager discussed the received bid for the Solid Waste Collection contract which expires at the end of the year. Councilors deliberated the pros and cons of a single hauler system and the expense associated with the single hauler versus the residents being able to select their own hauler. Representatives from the current hauler and only bidder, JP

Mascaro, provided additional details and expressed their support and the benefits of a single hauler system. The council will consider the award of the contract at their next regular council meeting.
